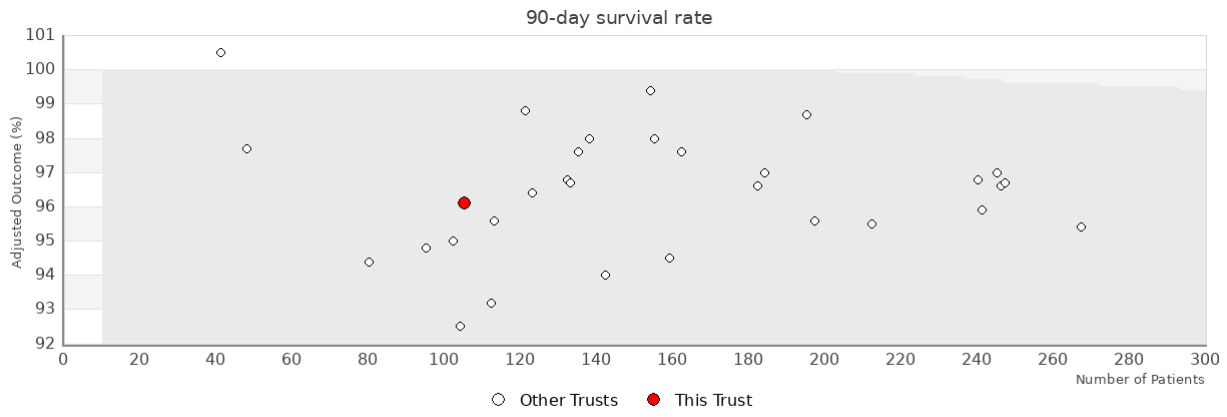

<b>Diagnosis</b>

<b>Waiting times</b>

– % seen by a clinical nurse specialist (CNS) at diagnosis (denominator: people with complete CNS data)	N/A	93.0%
